This is a very exciting collaboration with Marc Tickle! Marc and I have been working on this design for several months. I have designed the exterior, and Marc has designed the mirror systems and we both are working on the oil filled tube. Marc is making liquid filled ampoules for you!

The scope is an upright parlor mounted on a wood base, it's about 14" tall x 8" wide. I will work with you on the body; you can choose one of 3 designs to be on the front. I will cut them out you will foil and solder your piece.

Here is Marc's description of the mirror systems: Aurora-scopealis is a new mirror design unlike any other. It is interactive and dynamic, giving the viewer a light show reminiscent of an aurora borealis. Using both regular flash lights and black lights, the combination of colors is mesmerizing. Built with two tapered mirrors and three additional tapered dichroic mirrors, this scope also has a large single viewing port that offers a different view from the left to the right. The photos here show the actual mandala variations. The cell will include luminescent liquid filled ampoules. Marc and I will work with you on your cell.
