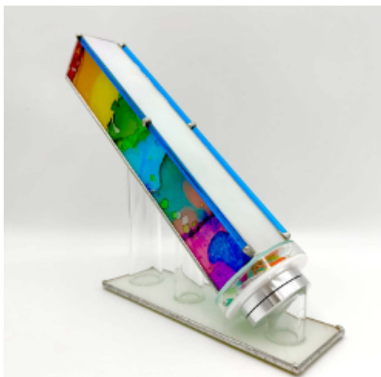
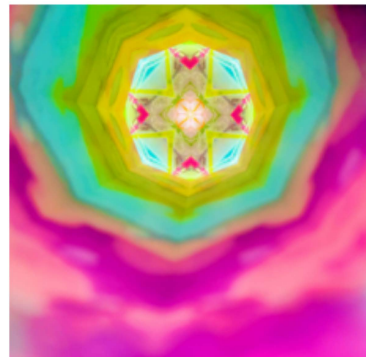
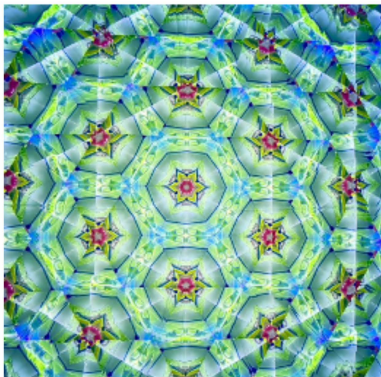

This double mirror system parlor kaleidoscope has a 4 point two-mirror translucent system and a three-mirror 30, 60, 90 mirror assembly. The 2-mirror has a 3rd side that is translucent glass, to be painted by the student in their own design with fast-drying alcohol inks. Light then enters through the exterior of the scope and creates a colorful tunnel of kaleidoscopic patterns surrounding the mandala at the end.

Both mirror systems stack together and fit perfectly in the pre-made stained glass painted exterior. Students will build their own dry cell that will include hand-made luminescent liquid filled ampules along with dichroic glass and other luminescent lampworked glass items. Students are welcome to bring along extra pieces to put in their cells. This scope will include a regular flashlight and also a black light to fully immerse themselves in all the combinations and different aspects of light-play in this piece. Finally the scope will be mounted onto the provided glass pedestal base and then coupled with the perfectly aligned cell on a precision bearing. All parts are fixed into place with UV glue. This class is quite involved and will be a full-day experience resulting in a unique high-end scope to be proud of.

**It's All A Matter Of Perspective.**

Students will assemble two different types of kaleidoscopes using a 5" copper barrel.

For the teleidoscope students will assemble a tapered three mirror system, secure this in one of the copper barrels and attach the crystal ball to the end.

For the kaleidoscope students will build a liquid cell using a glass globe and cabochon. This will allow us to use glycerin and UV curing glue. Lamp worked items, crystals and other items will be available for adding to the cell.

Students will assemble an equilateral three mirror system.

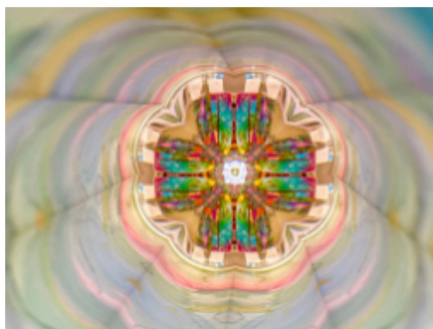
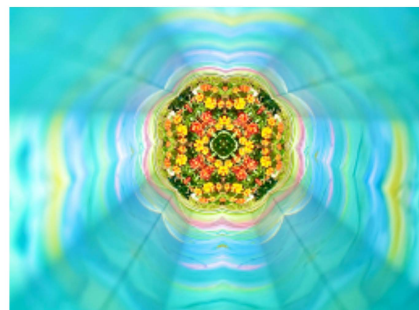

The new Translucent Teleidoscope Grande has been designed especially for this class. The reference to the translucency is in effect the 'third' side of a two-mirror scope. The mirror assembly will be constructed in a very new manner with precision techniques in mind. The outer body of the scope becomes that third side and depending on what colors and shapes are on the exterior, they will then surround the central mandala. One of the fun aspects of this class is that the students get to paint their own exterior paper inserts, and therefore they get to influence the interior image too. Lastly, a pure crystal glass sphere caps the scope, bringing in the viewer's surroundings and presenting everything in a tunnel of kaleidoscopic wonderment, unique to the maker's personal touches.

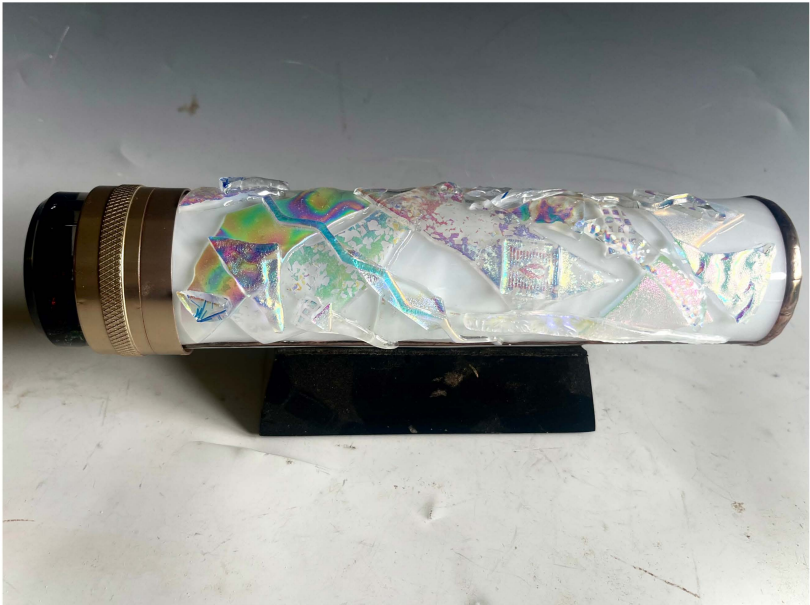

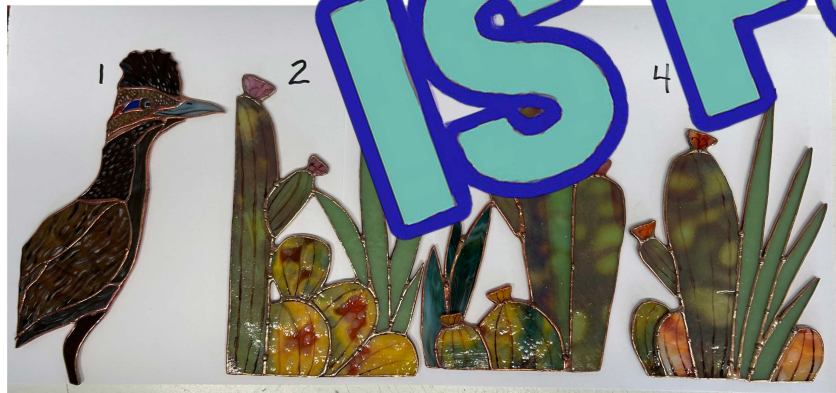
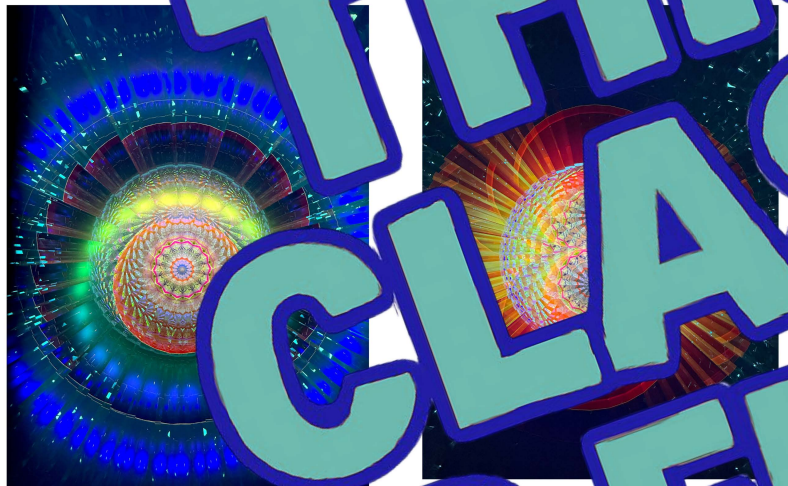
